Halacha of the Week	The general custom of Ashkenazim is to begin reciting Selichos on Motzei Shabbos. Why do we begin on Motzei Shabbos? Mishnah Berurah (581:6) explains that we always begin Selichos on Motzei Shabbos so there should be a uniform starting date for Selichos. Another explanation is offered by Sefer Leket Yosher. After Shabbos we are in a state of simcha (joy) because of the Torah which we have learned and our fulfillment of the mitzvah of Oneg Shabbos (enjoying the delicacies of Shabbos). It is in this atmosphere of simcha that we wish to begin reciting Selichos because the Divine Presence does not descend upon those who are depressed, but on those who experience the simcha of performing mitzvos (Shabbos 30b). On Motzei Shabbos, it is an auspicious time to begin beseeching Hashem for forgiveness.
