Halacha of the Week	With Yom Kippur falling out on Shabbos this year, please be aware of the following important halacha. Since it is Shabbos, there is a mitzva d'Oraisa of kiddush as always. The obligation to say kiddush over wine is only d'Rabanan (Magen Avraham) so there is still a mitzva d'Oraisa without wine. One can fulfill this mitzva by mentioning Shabbos in davening, but only if you have in mind to be yotzaih, since mitzvos tzrichos kavanah (Mishna Berurah). The Chasam Sofer states explicitly that one should have in mind to fulfill the mitzvah of kiddush when davening on Yom Kippur. Therefore, please be careful to have in mind to fulfill the mitzvah of kiddush when davening Shemoneh Esrei of Maariv on Yom Kippur. This applies to women as well.
