| Halacha of the Week | There is a widespread custom to conduct Hakafot (literally, "encirclings") on Simchat Torah, both at night and by day, after Maariv and Shacharit. We walk around the Bima seven times, singing praises to Hashem, dancing and clapping in the Torah's honor. Despite the fact that clapping and dancing are generally forbidden on Yom Tov and Shabbat, it is nevertheless permissible to dance and clap on Simchat Torah to give honor to the Torah. In fact, not only does Halacha permit clapping and dancing on Simchat Torah, it is considered an important Mitzva to do so. The Vilna Gaon would fervently clap and dance on Simchat Torah, his eyes fiery like a torch as he celebrated in honor of the Torah. | |
