Halacha of the Week	If a person makes an agreement with a non-Jewish worker to complete a task for a certain price, he can give the worker the item that needs the work any time before Shabbos, even if there is not enough time to complete the job before Shabbos. This concept is known as "katzatz" (coming to terms). Although the non-Jew may end up doing the work on Shabbos, the Jew did not tell him when to do the job. Any work the non-Jew decides to do on Shabbos is of his own volition. The Jew may not insist that the task be completed so soon after Shabbos that it would be impossible for the non-Jew to get it done without working on Shabbos. Making such a demand would be akin to instructing him to work on Shabbos. Accordingly, it is permissible to give one's car to a non-Jewish mechanic on Friday, even knowing that he will repair the car on Shabbos, but it is forbidden to do so with the stipulation that the car should be ready on Motzei Shabbos or early Sunday morning.
