Halacha of the Week	Why do we cover the challah during Kiddush? There are 3 reasons for this halacha: (1) In other circumstances, Hamotzi is generally recited before Hagofen. On Shabbos, when Kiddush is recited over wine, this is reversed. To protect the challah from "embarrassment" we cover it until Kiddush is completed. (2) Lechem mishneh commemorates the mon, which was delivered from Shamayim covered in dew. (3) In order to properly honor Shabbos, we are careful not to serve – or even reveal – the foods that will be eaten at the meal until after we sanctify the day. All of these reasons are taken into account, and the challah is covered even if just one of them applies.
