Halacha of the Week	What is the Torah obligation of Kiddush? There is a mitzva min haTorah to recite Kiddush – to sanctify the Shabbos – at the onset of Shabbos. The Torah obligation can be fulfilled by praising Shabbos. The Torah obligation of Kiddush also requires that Yetziyas Mitzrayim be mentioned. Mid'rabonon, Chazal instituted that Kiddush should be recited over wine or bread and that it should be recited at the beginning of a seudah. Based on the above, some Achronim hold that a person fulfills his Torah obligation of Kiddush when he davens Ma'ariv, and that later, when he actually makes Kiddush, he fulfills the mitzva mid'rabonon of reciting Kiddush over wine.
