Halacha of the Week	QUESTION: Wednesday evening, December 4, we begin reciting v'sain tal umatar in the Shmoneh Esrei of Maariv. What if one forgot to say v'sain tal umatar, and what is the halacha if one is uncertain? ANSWER: If a person said "v'sain beracha" instead of "v'sain tal umatar livracha", and realized his error after ending Shmoneh Esrei, the entire Shmoneh Esrei must be repeated. If the error was caught while in the middle of Shmoneh Esrei, corrective action may be taken by inserting the phrase of v'sain tal umatar livrocha in the bracha of Shema Koleinu, before the words of "Ki ata shomeiya". If the bracha of Shema Koleinu was already completed, but the bracha of Retzei was not yet begun, Shulchan Aruch (117:5) writes the phrase v'sain tal umatar livracha should be inserted between the two brachos. However, if he already began the bracha of Retzei, the individual must return to the beginning of the bracha of Bareich Aleinu and use the proper phrase of v'sain tal umatar.
