Halacha of the Week	My wife works in the city and comes home late. Should I light Chanukah candles at the prescribed time, or should I wait until she comes home? While lighting Chanukah candles is a mitzvah that is especially beloved, it should not come at the expense of family harmony and peace in the home. If one only has one candle on Friday, and cannot procure another, it should be used for Shabbos candles and not for Chanukah candles, because Shabbos candles were instituted to foster shalom bayis. In our case as well, lighting candles without waiting for one's wife to arrive will potentially have a negative impact on shalom bayis, and one should therefore wait until his wife comes home. Indeed, the Chafetz Chaim related that his Rebbi, R' Nochum of Horodna, was always exceedingly careful to light Chanukah candles at the proper time – but when his wife was late in coming home, he delayed lighting candles until she arrived.
