Halacha of the Week	QUESTION: I always taste the soup and other dishes on erev Shabbos to see if they need more spices. This erev Shabbos will be Asara B'Teves. Am I permitted to taste the food?  ANSWER: The Mishnah Berurah writes that it is a mitzvah on erev Shabbos to taste the food you prepare to make sure it is properly spiced. This is part of the mitzvah of honoring Shabbos. Yet one is not permitted to eat food on a fast day even if the intent is only to check on the spices. Nonetheless, Shulchan Aruch writes that on a fast day (except Yom Kippur and Tisha B'Av) one may taste a small amount of food, provided it is spit out and not swallowed. The Rema disagrees and writes that food may not be placed in the mouth, even if it will be spit out. The Mishnah Berurah cites the Chayei Adam that if one is preparing a seudas mitzvah, and without tasting the food it will not be possible to tell if it was spiced properly, one may rely on the Shulchan Aruch and taste the food and immediately spit it out. This leniency applies to preparing the Shabbos seuda as well.
