Halacha of the Week	Havdalah—sitting or standing? When a person is making Havdalah for others, the Rishonim differ on whether it should be recited sitting or standing. Some say that people who are being yotzei must share the same kevius (setting) as the one who is motzei them, and this is best achieved when they are all sitting. Others say that since we are escorting the King at the time of Havdalah (as the Shechina departs at the end of Shabbos), it is respectful to be standing. In their view, the kevius is achieved as long as everyone is gathered for the same purpose. Practically, there are two customs; some Gedolei Yisroel were mavdil standing and others were known to sit.
