The Rishonim disagree on whether a woman is obligated in Havdalah. Women should be stringent and make sure to fulfill the mitzvah. In deference to the opinion that women are exempt. Rema rules that women should not recite Havdalah themselves, but should hear it from a man. Others question this Halacha of the ruling and maintain that even if a woman is exempt, Week she is still permitted to say the brachos. Practically, a woman should try to hear Havdalah from a man. If this is difficult, she should recite it herself and drink the Havdalah wine. On Motzei Yom Kippur, if a woman is hungry and wants to break her fast before her husband comes home from shul, she can make Havdalah herself and break the fast.
