Halacha of the Week	Why do we say the bracha of Eish? The bracha of Eish was incorporated into the seder of Havdalah. Although this brocha is not connected to the concept of Havdalah, it is connected to Motzei Shabbos. It commemorates the creation of fire, which took place on Motzei Shabbos. If one does not have fire available, he does not have to delay Havdalah to procure fire. If at any time over the rest of Motzei Shabbos he sees fire, he can say the bracha then. Once the evening is over, he can no longer recite the brocha on eish.
