Halacha of the Week	Parshas Zachor – On the Shabbos before Purim we read a section from the Torah, (Devarim 25:17- 19), which reminds us of Amalek's surprise attack upon the unsuspecting B'nei Yisroel. Haman, a descendant of Amalek, continued in the cruel ways of his ancestors by dedicating his life to the destruction of B'nei Yisroel. The Torah obligates us, both men and women, to listen to the reading of Parshas Zachor from a Kosher Sefer Torah, once a year, to remember the nefarious deeds of Amalek. According to our commentators, it is the only Torah reading that is Biblically mandated. There is a "mitzvas asei" to remember the wickedness of Amalek and a "mitzvas lo sa'asei", not to forget.
